



## **PERSONAL CARE, GROOMING AND TATTOO BUSINESSES\***

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR COVID COMPLIANCE**

*\*Includes businesses that do not provide health care services, have workers who directly touch customers or have a piece of equipment which repeatedly come into contact directly with customers' skin such as barber shops, beauty salons (including waxing and hair removal) hair salons, nail salons, tattoo businesses, tanning salons and massage therapists.*

#### ***CAPACITY***

Emergency Maximum Occupancy- lowest number of one the following:

- 50% of stated fire capacity or no more than 12 customers for every 1000 square feet of total square footage including part not accessible to customers
- Limit number in the space so customers stay 6 feet apart
- Arrange seating so groups of customers are separated by 6 feet

#### ***FACE COVERINGS***

- All workers must wear face coverings
- Guests must wear Face Coverings except when receiving a service on the part of the face which is protected by the Face Covering
- Applicable exceptions may apply to some persons not wearing face coverings

#### ***CORE SIGNAGE, SCREENING AND SANITATION***

- Post Emergency Maximum Occupancy of facility
- Disinfect all equipment and furniture which comes into direct contact with customers between users
- Increase disinfection during peak times
- Post signs reminding guests and workers of maintaining 6 feet social distancing
- Perform frequent and routine cleaning of high touch areas especially during peak times
- Shall provide hand sanitizer for workers and guests and promote frequent hand washing
- Mark 6 feet of spacing in lines at point of sale and in other high traffic areas

Pursuant to the Governor's Orders, owners and staff of a business can be charged with Class 2 misdemeanor for violation of the Orders. Individuals, including guests, customers can be cited for a Class 2 misdemeanor for violation of the Face Covering requirement. *Revised 1.1.21*
