WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR COVID COMPLIANCE

CAPACITY

Emergency Maximum Occupancy- lowest number of one the following:

- 50% of stated fire capacity or no more than 12 customers for every 1000 square feet of total square footage
- Limit number in the space so groups stay 6 feet apart
- Arrange restaurant so customers at one table are not within 6 feet of another table
- At a counter- each group separated from another group at the counter by 6 feet

FACE COVERINGS

- Workers must wear face coverings
- Customers must wear face coverings except when actively eating or drinking
- Offer curbside delivery, home delivery or a reasonable alternative for customers who state an exception to the wearing of face coverings
- Applicable exceptions may apply to some persons not wearing face coverings

CORE SIGNAGE, SCREENING AND SANITATION

- Post Emergency Maximum Occupancy in noticeable place
- Post signs reminding guests and workers of maintaining 6 feet social distancing
- Perform frequent and routine cleaning of high touch areas especially during peak times
- Must provide hand sanitizer
- Mark 6 feet of spacing in lines at high traffic areas such as cash registers or waiting to be seated

LATE NIGHT SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Onsite sale and service of alcoholic beverages must cease between 9:00 pm and 7:00 am

Pursuant to the Governor's Orders, owners and staff of a business can be charged with Class 2 misdemeanor for violation of the Orders. Individuals, including guests and customers, can be cited for a Class 2 misdemeanor for violation of the Face Covering requirement. *Revised 1.1.21*
